Our courses offer structured creative learning that will help you progress as an artist and build confidence in your ability. Cost

We aim to keep our courses affordable to people on low incomes and offer payments by instalment. If you receive means-tested benefits or have a low income, you will be eligible for a reduced fee (we may ask you for evidence). Any fees charged in Band A provide a contribution towards administration costs, field trips and end of course performances and exhibitions; all direct learning is free of charge. If you are experiencing extreme hardship, let us know. Fees vary for those living outside of the Cambridgeshire & Peterborough Combined Authority region.

| Fee band | Short course | Year-long course* |
|--|--------------|-------------------|
| Band A: income under £22,500 or on means-tested benefit | FREE | £145 |
| Band B: income between £22,500 and £28,000 | £40 | £450 |
| Band C: income above £28,000 | £120 | £1,350 |

*The first six weeks of year-long courses are free and provide an introduction to your course.

Entry requirements

Courses are open to adults aged 19+ who live in the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough region and can travel independently to class. We prioritise new learners with health conditions or disabilities and those who are unpaid carers. You must be aged 19+ on 31 August 2023.
