## **AIMS & OBJECTIVES**

#### Course aim

Aimed for absolute beginners, this course will teach you the basics of the acoustic guitar. You will learn the layout of your guitar, how to play basic chords, how to transition between chords and how to tune your guitar, as well as how to maintain a good posture when playing. At the end of the course, you will have begun to build a repertoire of simple, well-known songs, such as Happy Birthday, Three Little Birds and Wild Thing. As the course progresses, you will also gain an understanding of the 12-bar Blues. Practice outside of the session is key for your successful development as a player. You can borrow a guitar from us for the duration of the course if needed – you will have to take this home in between sessions.
